

RECOVERED TUG IN YARD

Jim Steers May Be Restored to Operating Condition

The tugboat Jim Steers, brought to the surface Saturday afternoon, might be put back into service.

A spokesman for the owners of the tug, which sank mysteriously in Long Island Sound Jan. 19, said that there was still no trace of two of the craft's three-man crew. One body was recovered from the engine room on Saturday.

The spokesman added that the tug would be surveyed by midweek with a view to putting her back into condition. The Coast Guard, which has been conducting an investigation of her sinking, he said, had been informed of her location at the Sound Shipbuilding Corporation, 123-45 Lax Avenue, College Point, Queens. He said he assumed that Coast Guard investigators would also look the thirty-eight-foot craft over.
